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CHECKLIST FOR DOGS AND CATS BEING PREPARED FOR IMPORTATION INTO JAMAICA

Please use the checklist to verify if your pet meets the import conditions for entry into Jamaica

DOCUMENTATION		
- Valid Veterinary Import Permit		
- Official Veterinary Export Health Certificate signed by official government veterinarian or by an accredited veterinarian and endorsed by an official government veterinarian		
- I will have my pet's vaccination records and a copy of ALL blood test and other test results displaying the microchip no.		
MICROCHIPPING		
- My pet has been microchipped		
- I have proof of date of microchip implant (certificate/ receipt)		
RABIES VACCINATION		
- My pet has been vaccinated in accordance with the recommendation on the vaccine manufacturer's data sheet		
- My pet has been vaccinated for rabies and a copy of the rabies vaccination certificate		
- My pet was vaccinated against rabies AFTER it was fitted with a microchip		
RABIES TITRE TESTING		
- The blood sample was taken at least 30 days after the rabies vaccination		
- I have a certified copy of the blood test result (FAVN Titre Test) from an approved OIE laboratory, showing the correct microchip no. and the date the blood was taken		
OTHER TESTS AND TREATMENTS		
- External parasites (ticks, fleas etc.)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My pet was examined and treated twice, within 30 days and within 7 days prior to export 		
- Helminths (hookworms and roundworms) and tapeworms		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My pet was examined and treated twice, 14 days apart the last treatment being within 7 days prior to export 		
- Heartworm test and treatment (DOGS ONLY)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My dog was tested with a heartworm ELISA antigen test with negative results, within 30 days prior to travel 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My dog has been treated with a product registered for heartworm prevention 		
- Primary vaccination (including vaccination for Leptospirosis in DOGS ONLY)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My pet was vaccinated not less than 2 weeks prior to travel 		
- Leishmaniosis (DOGS ONLY)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My pet was tested for <i>Leishmania infantum</i> using an IFAT or ELISA test with negative results 		
- Coccidiosis (DOGS ONLY)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My pet was tested with an internationally recognized test with negative results 		
- Brucella canis (DOGS ONLY)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My pet was tested for <i>Brucella canis</i> with negative results within 45 days prior to travel. This test may not be required for dogs which have been spayed or neutered. 		
- Babesiosis, Lyme disease and Ehrlichiosis (DOGS ONLY)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My pet was tested using an approved test including ELISA for <i>Babesia canis</i>, <i>Babesia gibsoni</i>, <i>Borrelia Burgdorferi</i> and <i>Ehrlichia</i> with negative results within 16 days prior to travel 		
- Canine Transmissible Venereal Tumor and Canine Influenza (DOGS ONLY)		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My dog was examined within 7 days prior to export and found to be free of lesions, signs and symptoms 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My dog was NOT vaccinated for Canine Influenza.
