

Record Keeping and veterinary drugs



What are Good Agriculture Practices?

Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs) for livestock are routine activities or measures that ensure good animal health and welfare for optimal performance. It focuses on disease prevention and control management programmes.

It means animals will produce more milk, more eggs, more meat.

Healthy animals is a important step to producing safe food.

Animal Health & Welfare

This involves meeting the animals basic needs:

- 1. Freedom from hunger and thirst
- 2. Freedom from discomfort
- 3. Freedom from pain, injury and disease
- 4. Freedom from fear and distress
- 5. Freedom to engage in normal patterns of animal behaviour



Farm Hygiene

Facilities such as animal houses and milking parlors should be cleaned and disinfected every day. A sanitation programme must be put in place indicate the areas to be cleaned, cleaning procedure, frequency of cleaning, the cleaning agents used and person(s)



Biosecurity

The purpose of biosecurity is to minimize the potential for introducing disease-causing organisms onto your property or animals.
