#### HISTORY

- ⇒ The native Jamaican goat has been noted to be a mixture of breeds whose origins can be traced back to the 16th century.
- ⇒ This mixture of breeds has produced an eco-type, which has evolved mainly through natural selection and has become highly adapted to the agro-ecological condition of Jamaica.

#### **CHARACTERISTICS**

- ⇒ The native's colour ranges from brown, black, white and sometimes a mixture of each colour
- ⇒ The natives are of a small breed type having horn and bread and sometime wattles
- ⇒ Natives are hardy, tolerant of parasites.



#### **PERFORMANCE**

- The does are describe das good mothers with a high rate of twinning. The average birth weight of the offspring is 2.3kg.
- ⇒ The native is an early maturing type animal capable of breeding as early as five months, with a long breeding season
